**Day 1: Saturday, September 28<sup>th</sup>, 2017**

**Arrival Cairo - Welcome to Egypt**

Welcome to Egypt! You'll be met and assisted by a Tour representative at the Cairo airport and then escorted to your connecting flight to Aswan at **22:15**. Upon arrival to Aswan you will be escorted by Tour staff to the Movenpick hotel on Elephantine Island.

**Overnight Aswan: Movenpick Resort & SPA**

**Day 2: Sunday, September 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019**

**Aswan Dam and Isis Temple**

After breakfast we will visit **Philae Temple**. It was dedicated to the goddess Isis, the wife of Osiris and mother of Horus. These three characters are very important in ancient Egyptian life, culture and art. In the afternoon we will take a ride aboard a felucca, sailing around Kitchener's Island, after that depart by a motorboat to sail on the Nile to the **Botanical Gardens** and The **Nubian Village** that is located on West Bank of the River Nile in Aswan and just opposite to Soheil Island and near the Aswan Dam passing by the First Cataract of Aswan, this fantastic tour to the Nubian Village with **camel ride** on the desert lets you meet and impact with a Nubian family and to learn about their simple life style, culture and traditions, back to the hotel.

**Day 3: Monday, September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019**

**Abu Simbel Temple and Nubian Museum**

After breakfast we will depart by bus for **Abu Simbel**. The two temples in the Abu Simbel complex were carved out of the mountainside during the reign of Pharaoh Ramesses II, in the 13th century BCE, as a lasting monument to himself and his queen, Nefertari. After that we head back to Aswan, then the Tour staff will transfer you from the Aswan Movenpick hotel to the **5 Star Luxury Nile cruise ship**. Lunch on board, Afternoon we will visit the **Nubian Museum**, dedicated to Nubian history, culture and art. After the museum we will have the opportunity to enjoy high tea at a Nubian café, and watch the sunset. Then back to the Cruise.

**Day 4: Tuesday, October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019**

**Kom-Ombo and Horus Temples**

The ship will set sail. After breakfast we will journey first to **KomOmbo Temple**. The northern half was dedicated to the god Horus, and the Southern half to the crocodile god, Sobek. After the tour, we will return to the cruise ship and continue sailing to Edfu. After Lunch enjoy a visit to the **Temple Of Horus** in Edfu. It is one of the best preserved temples in Egypt and was dedicated the Falcon-headed god, Horus. After the tour, we will return to the ship and continue on to Luxor, passing through the Esna Lock.

**Day 5: Wednesday, October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2019**

**Dendara and Abydos Temples**

After breakfast we will travel by bus to **Dendara Temple**. It is one of the best-preserved temple complexes in Egypt and contains the Temple of Hathor. Afterwards, we will visit the temple at **Abydos**, dedicated to Pharaoh Seti I. Abydos one of the oldest cities of ancient Egypt, dating to pre-dynastic times. Then we will return to the Hotel. **Overnight: Nile Cruise / Luxor**

**Meals: Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner**

**Day 6: Thursday, October 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2019**

**Karnak and Luxor Temples**

After breakfast (by 7:30 AM) we will transfer off the Cruise Ship, and journey to the **Karnak Temple**. The temple complex has four parts. The most commonly visited one is the Precinct of Amun-Ra. In addition to this precinct we will visit the three other parts: the Precinct of Mut, the Precinct of Montu, and the ruins of the Temple of Amenhotep IV (more commonly known as Ankhatenen.). Then proceed to visit Adel's Oil Shop (For the people who want to do a session). Free time to enjoy the resort. In the evening (around 6:00 PM) we will visit the **Luxor Temple**. This is a large ancient temple complex, located on the east bank of the Nile River, and was founded in 1400 BCE. After touring the temple we will return to the hotel.

### Day 7: Friday, October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2019

#### **Valley of the Kings & Hatshepsut Temple**

After breakfast a visit to the **Valley of the Kings**, also called the Valley of the Gates of the Kings. For a period of nearly 500 years, from the 16th to 11th century BC, tombs were constructed there for the Pharaohs and powerful nobles of the New Kingdom. The valley stands on the west bank of the Nile, opposite Thebes (modern Luxor), within the heart of the Theban Necropolis. After that we will go to the Ibis Alabaster shop for an opportunity to shop for souvenirs and gifts. Afterwards we will visit the nearby **Temple of Queen-Hatshepsut**. This mortuary temple is dedicated to the sun god Amon-Ra and is located next to the mortuary temple of Mentuhotep II. Afterwards we will visit **Habu Temple** After lunch back to the hotel.

**Overnight: Overnight: Maritim Jolie Ville Hotel**

### Day 8: Saturday, October 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019

#### **Memphis / Step Pyramid at Sakkara / Serapeum of Saqqara**

After breakfast our tour staff will transport you to the Luxor airport, to fly to Cairo. Upon arrival in Cairo, we will visit **Memphis** and **Sakkara** the Pyramid of Djoser, or step pyramid is an archeological remain in the Saqqara necropolis, northwest of the city of Memphis. It was built 27th century BC during the Third dynasty for the burial

of Pharaoh Djoser by his vizier, Imhotep, then tour a date palm farm and visit a training center for carpet marking, After lunch we will visit the **Serapeum of Saqqara**. Then back to the hotel.

### Day 9: Sunday, October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2019

#### **The pyramids and Sphinx**

After breakfast we will visit the last remaining Wonder of the Ancient World the **Great Pyramids** and the **Sphinx**. After Lunch back to the hotel.

In the evening there will be an optional opportunity to have **private time inside to the Great Pyramid King's Chamber and Queen's Chamber**.

### Day 10: Monday, October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019

#### **Egyptian Museum and Alabaster Mosque**

After Breakfast we will go to the **Cairo Egyptian Museum**. This museum contains many important pieces of ancient Egyptian history and houses the world's largest collection of Pharaonic antiquities. This includes many treasures from the tomb of King Tutankhamen. Then we will go to visit the great Alabaster Mosque. Situated on the summit of a centuries-old citadel, this is a fine example of an Ottoman-era mosque. Then Evening Depart to Aswan by flight and Overnight.
